

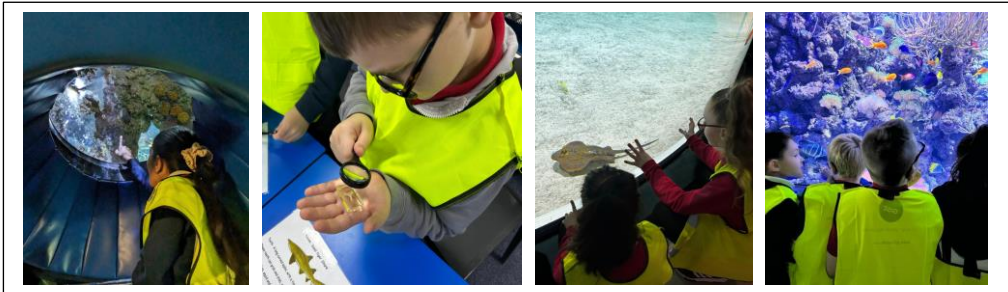
Message from the Headteacher
