SKIPPING SCHOOL FRIDAY 23RD MAY

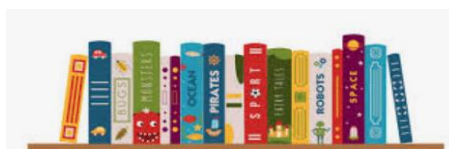
