What we provide...

Breakfast and After School Club provides out of school provision for 3 – 11 year olds, Monday to Friday term-time only.

Breakfast Club is open from 7:45am. The practitioners will take the children into class at 08:50am.

The cost for Breakfast Club is £3.

After School Club is open until 5:45pm. The practitioners will collect the children from their classroom at the end of the school day.

The cost for After School Club is £9*.

To book your child into any of the sessions, please see the Early Years Reception team to fill in an admissions form.

*** If you wish for your child to stay just until 4pm for after school club, the cost is £3 however they will not receive a snack and if they are collected after 4pm there will be a £9 charge.**



As a school, we have a comprehensive set of policies and procedures that are available for parents/carers to view on our school website, or by request.

Routine and Curriculum

Practitioners liaise with parents and teaching staff daily to share relevant information to ensure your child is settled and happy.

We aim to provide an engaging environment for the children by giving them the opportunity to choose and select different activities each day, based on their interests.



Breakfast Club

As our school promotes healthy eating, the children are offered a nutritious breakfast. A variety of cereals and fruit are provided along with toast and milk or water.

Children eat together around a table in a happy, sociable environment.

After School Club

After school, your child will be provided with an afternoon snack with a choice of milk or water and a piece of fruit.

Just like in Breakfast Club, children eat together around a table in a happy, sociable environment. We promote healthy eating and encourage children to use good table manners.



Our snack menu varies on a day-to-day basis and includes; toasted crumpets, toasted muffins, cheese sandwiches & salad, spaghetti on toast, pizza & salad and baked beans on toast.

Please note that this is a snack menu and the snacks are not a substitute for a nutritional evening meal.
