



Dear Parents,

As you know, **from the end of today school is closed for all children** except those of key workers until further notice. These parents have been contacted separately.

Your child will have brought home a pack of activities and if you are self-isolating these will have been posted through your door. These work sheets will give you examples of the kinds of tasks children can do –you could use them to create your own examples by changing the numbers in maths problems or asking similar questions about different books. Don't forget that the school day also includes break time, PE, ICT, Art and lots of different creative activities, not just written work!
