Can you talk about the story after you have read/listened to it? Can you talk about the different characters? What did you like about the story?

To also help children to read at home, Ruth Miskin are streaming phonics, reading and spelling lessons every weekday on their Youtube channel. The speed sounds lessons are exactly the same format as we do at school so your child will be familiar working in this way.

To find out which set to watch, please ask your child which adult they work with in phonics, then see the chart which is on the school website under parents - Homelearning.

Read Write Inc reading books at the correct level for your child are also available on Oxford Owl.

Look again at the chart to find out which colour your child is on.

Writing/Topic

Can you practice writing your full name....first name and surname.

This half term we would have been learning all about minibeasts. We would have been looking for different creatures that live in our gardens.

Can you go on a mini beast hunt? You can use the attached hunt sheet to help you

Draw or paint a picture of your favourite minibeast.

Can you talk about the lifecycle of a Butterfly? How does it change from an egg to a caterpillar, to a cocoon to a butterfly.
