HANDWRITING PHRASES FOR HELPING YOUR CHILD TO FORM LETTERS

This works best if your child practises for a short time every day.

1. Show the picture side and air-write as you say the phrase.
2. Ask your child to practise in the air with you.
3. Using a sharp pencil and sat at a table, encourage your child to have a go.
4. Praise your child for their efforts.

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| <p>Maths</p> <p>Counting everyday is invaluable. Continue to count forwards and backwards to 100. Can you start at 16, 27, 35, 49 etc? Practise counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. Carry on counting in 10's 10, 20 ... Carry on counting in 10's 3, 13, 23 ... Carry on counting in 10's 96, 86, 76</p> <p>Can you write all your number bonds to 10?</p> <p>Now try number bonds to 20</p> <p>Time Use the clock to keep you on track with your daily routine. Talk about what you do in the morning, afternoon, evening. Learn to tell the time and recognise o'clock and half past. Then try quarter past.</p> <p>Money Continue to learn to recognise different coins and their value. Play at shopping using 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins.</p> <p>Other Basic Skills -why not have a go at one of these 10 Minute Maths sheets each day? We've done some like this at school.
