

Practise writing your full name correctly.

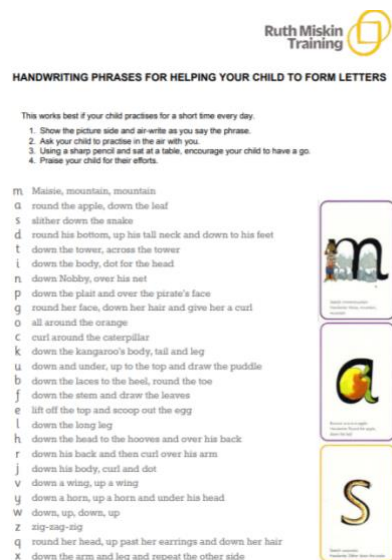
Spellings
