

Making a woodland crown

Woodland crowns can be made in any season. Go outside and make yours now!

Equipment:

- seed, leaf and flower templates
- card
- paint or colouring pencils
- glue and sticky tape
- wide cardboard strip
- natural objects
- scissors

Method

- 1 Go on a woodland hunt.
- 2 Find natural objects such as nuts, flowers, twigs and leaves.
- 3 Take them back to the classroom.
- 4 Draw around the woodland shape templates onto card.
- 5 Cut them out and colour them in.
- 6 Stick the shapes and natural objects to the wide cardboard strip.
- 7 Put the finished crown around your head and stick the ends together.
