



Maths Home Learning Task



By the end of Year 1, children should know and recognise the value of different denominations of coins and notes.



This is something you can look at together at home in a practical way. Have a look at real coins and notes and allow children to look closely at them.



- What is each coin or note worth?
- Which is worth the most?
- Which is worth the least?
- What number can you see written on the coin or note?
- How much money do you have altogether?
- Talk about the difference between pounds and pence.
- Make a pretend shop and give items a price. Do you have the correct coin to buy the item or do you need to put coins together?
- What happens if you pay too much money? Talk about how you would need to find the change.

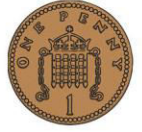


Have fun playing and exploring ways of using money!
