Dear Parents,

Yesterday I took part in a Covid update meeting with staff from Public Health. The messages about Covid rates and transmission in Rotherham, as in much of the country, were positive which is fantastic. I know from talking to the children how many of them are enjoying being able to see more people and take part in more activities and this is so important for them. At the minute, the guidance for primary schools has not really changed. We are still expected to keep in place our Covid measures including engaging with the NHS test and trace process and adults wearing masks in areas where we cannot guarantee social distancing.

I do understand how frustrating these measures can be for parents (and the staff and children) but after many children have been out of school for so long during lockdowns we have to continue doing everything we can to have as few bubble closures as possible.
