Please remember you should not send your child to school if they have Covid symptoms or have tested positive for Covid themselves.

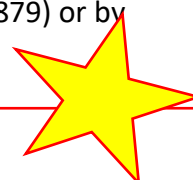
If your child is identified as a close contact, you are advised to book a PCR test and they can return to school if it is negative and they feel well.
